Project criteria	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Directly benefit a Threatened Species and/or Threatened Ecological Community (p. 9 of guidelines or go to https://www.environment.gov.au/topics/threatened-species-ecological-guidelines) • Commence before 1 December 2017 • Completed by 30 June 2019 (\$20,000 to \$60,000) or 30 June 2020 (\$60, 010 to \$100,000) • Include planting of native trees with potential 2 metre height • Have written consent of property/manager.
