**Funding program**                **Home Ground Advantage**

**Availability of grant**            There are two funding rounds each year. The winter round opened on 1 June 2017 and closes on 31 August 2017.

**Availability of funding**        Sporting clubs can request any amount (up to the full \$250,000) however most grants average \$12,500.

**Contribution**                      Not required

**Eligible Organisations**        Sporting clubs or community organisations which run and support sporting activities within Australia.

**Objectives of program**        The purpose of the program is to provide financial assistance to local sporting clubs and community organisations to develop their clubrooms, sporting grounds and general facilities, and invest in the growth and development of their emerging talent.

**Eligible projects**                Funding is available for the following types of projects:

1. Tangible projects - including upgrading, constructing or improving facilities, upgrading or purchasing equipment and buying uniforms and other assets
2. Developing exceptional talent - including special coaching or funding for trips to compete or gain experience.

The following items will not be funded: recurring operational expenses, repayment of debt, projects that have already been completed.
