The Queensland Arts Showcase Program provides funding to support individuals, organisations or collectives to deliver vibrant and accessible arts and cultural experiences for Queensland.

Availability of grant	Applications are accepted at any time.
Available funding	Funding is available across three streams: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Arts Ignite - funding up to \$60,000 for the development and presentation of new works, cultivation of new talent, and extension of organisational practice, audience and markets.• Arts Illuminate - funding of up to \$100,000 to engage acclaimed artists to present unique arts experiences to communities and to build local capacity through collaborative activities with acclaimed artists.• Arts Impact - funding of up to \$60,000 support a diverse range of arts and cultural experiences for communities and support initiatives that drive cultural tourism or activate existing infrastructure.
Contribution	Applicants must provide a co-contribution to project costs. Applicants must provide a co-contribution of at least 50% for applications under the Arts Illuminate stream.
Eligibility	Funding is available for individuals, organisations and collectives. Applicants must have an ABN, be over 18 years of age, have satisfied any previous AQ reporting requirements, be based in Queensland or show how the activity directly benefits the Queensland arts and cultural sector.
Objectives of program	The program invests in: the development and growth of a vibrant and accessible arts and cultural sector, strengthening connections with new audiences, supporting collaborations to develop innovative and quality arts and cultural experiences, strengthening professional development and creating employment and training opportunities.
Eligible projects	Funding may not be used for planning and maintenance of infrastructure, capital or equipment costs, fundraising activities and competitions, core business activities, training and study, touring costs, filmmaking.
