<b>Grant Provider</b>	Office of Liquor and Gaming Regulation, Department of Justice and Attorney-General
<b>Funding Program</b>	<b>Gambling Community Benefit Fund (GCBF) - Round 100</b>
<b>Availability of Grant</b>	Round 100 is now open and will close 28 February 2019. There are four funding rounds each year, with closing dates: 28 February, 31 May, 31 August and 30 November.
<b>Availability of Funding</b>	Eligible groups can apply for grants from \$500 to \$35,000
<b>Co-contribution</b>	Not required
<b>Objectives of Program</b>	To allocate funding to not-for-profit community groups to enhance their capacity to provide services, leisure activities and opportunities for Queensland communities.
<b>Eligibility</b>	Eligible organisations must have not-for-profit objectives, be community based, and be registered on the GCBF online portal as a legal entity or a sponsored organisation.
<b>Eligible Projects</b>	Applicants can apply for any item, except those that are listed as ineligible items in the Guidelines. Applications are prioritised from 1 (highest) to 5 (lowest): <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Applications by organisations affected by a declared natural disaster in the last two years</li> <li>2. Applications for purchase of equipment and facility improvements</li> <li>3. Applications for purchase of buses, cars, trailers and other vehicles</li> <li>4. Applications for community events, training, workshops, programs and festivals</li> <li>5. Applications by organisations that have received a grant from the GCBF of more than \$15,000 in the past two years.</li> </ol>
