Availability of Funding	Grant applications up to a maximum of \$4,000 will be considered.
Co-contribution	Not required
Objectives of Program	The objectives of the Program are to acknowledge and commemorate those who served Australia and its allies in wars, conflicts and peace operations. The Program is designed to preserve Australia's wartime heritage and to involve people throughout the nation in a wide range of projects and activities that highlight the service and sacrifice of Australia's service personnel in wars, conflicts and peace operations, and promote appreciation and understanding of the role that those who served have played in shaping the nation.
Eligibility	To be eligible, an applicant must be one of the following entity types: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Company, Cooperative, Indigenous corporation, Incorporated association. • Local government, State/Territory Government entity. • Statutory entity, Trustee on behalf of a Trust, unincorporated association
Eligible Projects	Local community-based projects or activities that directly commemorate the involvement, service and sacrifice of Australia's service personnel in wars, conflicts and peace operations are eligible for funding. Eligible activities include, for example: new and restoration of existing war memorials, commemorative plaques and honour boards / rolls; restoration, preservation and / or display of wartime memorabilia; commemorative events; publications / website; public awareness activity; school initiative.
