Funding Program	<p>UCF Small Grants - The Universal Charitable Fund offers small grants to charitable organisations for projects that make an impact, in areas of education, health, building sustainable communities, children and youth.</p> <p>The UCF was founded by local business people in South Australia as a simple and cost-effective way to provide practical support and encouragement to local charities doing a terrific job in helping people in need both in Australia and overseas.</p>
Grant Amount	Usually up to \$2,000
Grant Availability	Applications can be submitted at any time and applications are considered on a regular basis. Projects are assessed for their ability to make a significant difference for those the project is designed to assist.
Co-contribution	Not required
Applicant Eligibility	Applicants must be Australian registered charitable organisations with Deductible Gift Recipient status (DGR1) and tax deductibility. Most organisations receiving grants have an income of less than \$1 million.
